### How to Request Courses

- Please read any instructions provided on this document, on the website, and in weekly updates. We provide all the answers you'll need, so take a look at these resources for quick answers. See important dates listed above. See important contacts listed above who can answer questions
- When Registration opens for your student (*see dates above*), **you will find the link for the Course Request Form in the primary contact's portal in the Course Requests tab.** This new form is super easy to navigate,
- **Please note that processing times can take up to a week for all forms and all class requests, so hang tight!** Emailing multiple times a day will slow down response times
- **Requests are processed in the order they are received.** There is no way to jump the queue ahead of other students as we want to honor our students and staff. Emailing Professors, staff, and Administrators will not result in jumping the queue ahead of other students
- **Once a student is scheduled to class rosters, the Class Schedule can be downloaded from the E-Locker in your portal.** If you do not see a class you requested, the class is either full (*see note on waitlists below*) or there is a pending Graduate class request. Families will only be notified if they are scheduled to classes from a waitlist or when Professors return their approvals for Graduate class requests, so if you don't see a class you requested, just hang tight a little longer!
- **Email the Registrar for requests to change your class schedule. This includes Adds and Drops. Requests are processed by order of submission, and processing times are 1 week**
- **The final day to request courses for the Spring 2022 quarter is 3/25/22.** If this deadline is missed, students are encouraged to enroll for the following quarter as the College of Adaptive Arts is a lifelong learning model and we will be very excited to see them!

### Waitlisted Classes

- **Once a class roster is full, students will be added to a waitlist for the class. Students will only be added from the waitlist if spots open up on the roster** (meaning another student dropped the class). Because of this, waitlisted students may not hear from the Office of the Registrar about whether or not they are added to a class from the waitlist until after Week 2 of the quarter, so hang tight!

- All requests are processed by order of submission, and it is important to CAA to honor our students and staff. Emailing Professors, staff, and Administrators will not result in jumping the queue ahead of other students

### Highly Popular Classes offered on Multiple Days

- **Please note that due to the enormous popularity of some of our courses, we are now offering some of these courses on multiple days! Additionally, students may now take only one day of a course that is offered on multiple days.** Examples of these classes are Pound Fitness, Reading Partners, Dance of Peace, Children's Music, Pop Culture, Sign Language, and Traditional Arts

- If you have already submitted your Course Request Form and you requested multiple days of a course, our team will schedule you to the day that looks like it would be the best fit for your schedule, especially if you were planning to take onsite classes. Once your form is processed, they will reach out to you to notify you that weren't scheduled to multiple days, and to see if you'd like to request an additional class to keep you at the number of classes you requested on your Course Request Form. Please respond within a few days so they're able to process your Add request quickly.

- Thank you for your understanding - we are thrilled that these classes are so popular, and we know you'll love exploring one of our other amazing classes!

### Add/Drop Period

- The Add/Drop period is the first week of the Spring 2022 quarter, 4/4/22 - 4/8/22. Only students who requested classes during the Spring 2022 registration periods will be eligible to add/drop classes. To add or drop a class, email the Office of the Registrar (*see contacts above*)

- Requests are processed in the order they were received. Processing times take up to 1 week, so hang tight! There is no way to jump the queue ahead of other students. Once your request is processed, you'll be able to download your updated Class Schedule from the E-Locker in your portal

### **Frequently Requested Info about CAA Funding Inquiries at Regional Centers**

**When meeting with your case manager to complete a POS form requesting class coverage, you may need the following information**

- \*Students should submit hours requests for blocks of two quarters
- \*Up to 12 classes: 12 hours per week/120 per quarter may be covered
- \*Consumers must get pre-approval for hours intended for POS coverage prior to quarterly attendance
- \*CAA is a charitable nonprofit
- \*CAA offers private diplomas that are non-transferrable to state-accredited
- \*CAA's s vendor number is ZS0975
- \*CAA's budget code is 102
- \*Class sessions are 1 unit (hour) per week
- \*Each class meets for 10 weeks per quarter:
  - 1 unit x 10 weeks = 10 units total per class/per qtr
- \*Current and future quarter dates are included on CAA's emailed "Weekly Updates" documents each Monday morning. Current quarter start/end dates are also on the current class schedule, available on our website: [www.collegeofadaptivearts.org](http://www.collegeofadaptivearts.org)
- \*All students are 18 years of age or older; there is no time or age limit for
- \*Students may take one class and receive a certificate, take classes from time to time, pursue a CAA diploma in a selected field of study, pursue new diploma tracks on an ongoing basis, etc
- \*CAA provides opportunities for lifelong adult education in a collegiate environment emphasizing personal responsibility, self-advocacy, independence, community involvement, and applied cognitive skill-building through learning and class/community
- \*An example of student objectives connected to their studies, including benchmark ("before") and target ("after") goals, include a level of current occurrence (ex: advocacy or health and wellness-related activities) and sustained or additional outcomes through experience in a particular class or classes
- \*CAA class credits, applied toward students' diploma or certificate goals, are awarded based on exposure to and experience with class concepts at each individual student's own pace and level of ability with instruction toward increased independent use of skills
  - 0-1 days=0 credit
  - 2-4 days=1 credit
  - 5-7 days=2 credits
  - 8-10 days=3 (*full credit for the class*)
